

PARENT REQUEST FOR SERVICES



I am formally requesting that an educational audiologist be involved in my child's care due to his/her hearing loss or auditory processing disorder. In IDEA, the audiologist addresses assistive technology and assistive technology services (34CFR300.5-.6 & C). Based on professional scopes of practice in audiology (AAA, 2004; ASHA, 2018), speech-language pathology (ASHA, 2007), and deaf education (CEC, 2018), the audiologist is the only professional that is qualified to fit and verify hearing aids and personal hearing assistance technology (HAT).

Keystone Classroom is a practice providing these services which could include:

- Interpretation of diagnostic audiology results with the educational team
- Member of the IEP/504 team in creating appropriate accommodations
- Classroom observations & assessment for appropriate environmental changes and teaching strategies
- Fitting, management, and troubleshooting hearing assistive technology
- Annual in-services for staff to review current test results, implications in the classroom, and current accommodations in place
